

Faculty Positions at KAIST

The School of Digital Humanities and Computational Social Sciences in the College of Liberal Arts and Convergence Science at KAIST (Korea Advanced Institute of Science and Technology) invites applications for tenure-track positions in the areas of **(1) Asian Literature (including Korean literature) (2) Digital Humanities (3) Computational Linguistics (4) Developmental or Quantitative Psychology* (5) Sociology (CSS)* (6) Communication (CSS)***.

* We welcome applicants from the fields of sociology, communication and developmental or quantitative psychology who have a strong background in computational social science (CSS) methodologies.

We are looking for ambitious scholars of outstanding promise, who have experience in developing **interdisciplinary research** programs in line with the goals and visions of the School of Digital Humanities and Computational Social Sciences. We are particularly interested in scholars in these fields with tangible prospects of interdisciplinary research conducted in close partnership with engineering and natural science fields. Successful candidates should have a doctorate in her/his relevant discipline (**awarded earlier than or by December 2023**), a strong publication record which includes at least one or more SCI, SSCI, A&HCI, Scopus and should be able to provide the evidence of excellence in teaching.

KAIST is an internationally ranked and renowned research university based in Daejeon, South Korea. As a rapidly expanding global institution, KAIST mandates English as the primary language of instruction. Salaries and benefits are comparable to those of major research universities in the U.S., and negotiable depending on qualifications.
